**Happy Birthday Sagittarius the Archer!** To all of those born from November 22 - December 21! Key Phrase for Sagittarius is "I SEEK "

**Sagittarians** are the Idealists and dreamers of the zodiac. Sagittarius is a mutable (changeable, flexible), fire (intuitive, impulsive, idealistic) sign located in the Western Hemisphere of the chart. Your ruling planet is expansive and "benefic" **Jupiter**. Jupiter and the sign of Sagittarius reside in the 9<sup>th</sup> house of the zodiac. The 9<sup>th</sup> house is typically linked to long distance travel, philosophies and belief systems, religions, higher education and teaching, publishing, counseling and legal issues as well as exploring new horizons. Sagittarius sure does love to teach...or preach for that matter! Horses are usually linked to the sign of Sagittarius and the 9<sup>th</sup> house although most large animals coincide to the 12<sup>th</sup> house. I'll discuss why horses are in the 9<sup>th</sup> when Chiron is mentioned later in the newsletter. There is always that urge to align themselves with a greater ideal, truth and understanding of all subjects. Sagittarians may appear to act larger than life...well if your ruling planet was Jupiter you might feel the same! Jupiter does become excessive at times and that often translates to being overly idealistic, self-righteous and opinionated.

Jupiter, Sag's ruling planet, has a cycle of approximately 12 years. The planet Jupiter is our largest planet and is known to have quite a few moons! In fact, we aren't even sure how many moons (women) Jupiter has because new ones are surfacing and being discovered all the time! That Jupiter was discovered to have so many more moons shouldn't surprise us because it is the planet of "abundance". He was also known to be a womanizer in mythology. In the October issue of Lunar Notes, we discussed Juno, Jupiter's wife. She was acutely aware of how many moons, I mean women, were in Jupiter's life. Whatever Jupiter touches by transit in your birth chart will literally expand in nature. Jupiter can bring wonderful gifts and some have even called him "Santa Claus". However, you know the expression about

too much of a good thing, right? Sometimes when Jupiter transits areas of your chart, there can be financial gain or weight gain! Excessive behavior, exaggeration or over doing it can be linked to Jupiter.

According to Ariel Guttman and Kenneth Johnson's *Mythic Astrology*, correlations between Chiron, Jupiter and Sagittarius are apparent. It was known that Jupiter spent most of his time pursuing his many love interests. The question of faithfulness always surfaces when discussing the sign of Sagittarius because Sagittarians are always searching or wanting the next adventure, particularly if it is outdoors. They are usually committed to their current partner and that isn't usually the issue. "But how LONG they can sustain themselves in that commitment is another question. "Til Death do us part" is not a credo that Sagittarians hold dear (unless the chart contains strong Juno or Cancer symbolism)..and when pushed against the wall to say those words they usually tremble".

Sagittarius' polar opposite (9th house - higher educations, beliefs, philosophies, legal matters, publishing and teaching) is the mutable, air sign Gemini (3rd house - thoughts, communication, siblings, early education including teachers, short distance travel and automobiles). The integration and forming of philosophies and beliefs are some areas of life for Sagittarius, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite, the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Sagittarius can become ...just like mutable, airy Gemini, ruled by Mercury and become scattered and fickle and non-committal.

**CHIRON - The Wounded Healer, Teacher, Seeker, Maverick, Marriage indicator**

"He's everything you want, he's everything you need, he's everything inside of you that you wish you could be, he says all the right things, at exactly the right time, but he means nothing to you and you don't know why" - Vertical Horizon

In Mythology, when Chiron was born, his mother rejected him because he was born a Centaur...half man and half horse. When his parents Hera & Zeus saw their new son's image they abandoned him, repulsed by his body and physical form. Chiron's first wound was psychological - one of abandonment and rejection and a perpetual longing for the love and "relationship" to his parents, especially that of his mother.

Chiron's physical wound was in his foot and thigh, injured by a poison arrow, affecting his mobility. Sagittarians (horses) need lots of freedom to roam around. When that freedom is restricted or there is a "perceived" restriction then Chiron/Sagittarius really feels wounded. There can't be anything worse than being trapped in a physical body that doesn't feel right to us. Chiron spent much time in his cave studying the stars, medicine, spirituality, mathematics and music. He was able to utilize these disciplines to heal others and in turn heal himself; hence, The Wounded Healer archetype. The astrological glyph or symbol for the sign of Sagittarius is just that, a Centaur holding a bow and arrow pointed to the heavens...and into the distance.

One of Chiron's life lessons is relinquishing his painful memories from childhood. Because Chiron is immortal, his pain and suffering is eternal. Much of his pain was of his own making. When we are able to heal our primary wound (s) in life, we are usually able to utilize that experience to assist others with similar wounds and painful life experiences and in turn, heal our self. That is if we choose this path. Oftentimes, people can be in so much emotional pain and turmoil, or have not forgiven their parents, others or themselves so they choose to harm others as a projection of their own needs not having been met. A vicious cycle ensues and you will attract others to play out your dramas for you to take a look at, time and time again.

As Chiron matured, he became quite a wise teacher (Sagittarius/Jupiter) and a Shaman/Healer. The placement of Chiron in your birth chart shows your deepest wound by house

position and aspects it makes to other planets and cusps (the divisions of the signs) in your birth chart. This is also the place you will find your greatest strengths and ability to heal others and where you are able to exert or project this knowledge out into the environment. Chiron connections are very significant in synastry. Synastry is the comparison of two birth charts that shows compatibility and relationship dynamics to each other. When people enter into relationships where there is a strong Chiron connection, the relationship takes on a fated quality. Recent studies have confirmed Chiron as a marriage or partnership indicator. Bizarre Reversals in relationships or between the charts are possible. However, relationships indicated by Chiron are usually not easy at first. The difficulties inherent in Chironic relationships must be overcome for the personal growth of both individuals. That is the test of Chiron's placement in relationship comparison. ### Tarot Card # 20 XIV - Temperance - Symbolic of Sagittarius

In the Rider-Waite version, you see the Angel Temperance - Archangel Michael. He has the solar symbol on his head with light rays streaming outward from it. In each hand a cup is held, one cup is silver (feminine) and one is gold (masculine). Water pours and vibrates (waves) and is blended from one cup to the other. This blending of fire and water, masculine and feminine and the conscious and unconscious also symbolizes conception. The number 14 is the most fertile day of a woman's cycle. It is also the approximate number of days it takes from the New moon to the Full Moon each month.

Positively Temperance is adapting to circumstances, accommodating as well as gathering facts and expanding ones experiences. Negatively, blind faith, restlessness and excess and feelings of self righteousness are possible.

The Symbol of Temperance may appear in a reading during a time when emotional balance is required. The expression "patience is a virtue" applies here. There may be emotional days ahead or a need to balance and/or adapt our emotions to bring about positive and "creative" results. If this card turns up next to the Empress or the Sun, a conception or baby may be on the way!

### LONG SNOWS MOON (Elk)

In Native American Astrology, those born from November 22nd- December 21st are born under the Long Snows Moon and their animal totem is the Elk. Their color is black and obsidian is their totem in the mineral kingdom. Obsidian is a type of volcanic glass that is usually shiny like glass. It has razor-sharp edges and therefore should always be "handled carefully." Obsidian was used in carvings and for jewelry as well as for mirrors. It was also crafted for use in arrowheads. Because obsidian comes from deep within the earth it is said to be grounding.

Elk people are very similar to the properties of obsidian. They can be good mirrors for other people as well as project "their stuff" onto others. They are often rough around the edges or difficult to get to know because of their uneven outer surface. Elk people can be

very protective of those they love or from "perceived" danger. "They try to get as many cows as they can into their harem, and they will fervently defend them from the approaches of any other male". (Medicine Wheel-Earth Astrology, Sun Bear and Wabun) They are often introspective and clairvoyant. The Elk is a very strong and elegant animal and perhaps one of the most regal in the deer family. Men of this totem are competitive with each other about the women in their lives and can be prone to fits of rage or jealousy that may come as a surprise to those close to them.

**December, 2005**

**Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 ½ days.**

**December 1, 2005: New Moon 09 Sagittarius 31'** - The New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've placed on hold. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. In Sagittarius, new beginnings in this area of life could be beginning a new class or area of study, cultivating a new sports routine, travel to a foreign land or expanding your view of the world!

**December 4, 2005 - Mercury turns Direct at 24 Scorpio 50'** Mercury in penetrating Scorpio turns direct after its backwards retreat that started on November 14th. Whenever Mercury is retrograde we need to reflect and redo something. It was not a time to initiate anything new. Now you can feel free to purchase any electronic or computer equipment. Mercury will pass the degree it turned rx on December 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2005, Mars turns direct 08 Taurus 14'.** Mars turned retrograde at **23 Taurus 22'** - Mars will stay retrograde in the sign of Taurus until **December 10<sup>th</sup>** and will move forward at 8 degrees 14 minutes. If you have any planets from 24 to 8 degrees in the fixed signs especially, you will be affected if you have planets in the sign of Taurus, Scorpio, Leo and Aquarius. You will also be affected if you have any planets in the sign of Aries, since Mars is the ruler of Aries. In Taurus, Mars feel a little stifled at first. He is slow to warm up. Yet once he gets moving he begins to pick up strength and endurance and is in it for the long haul. When retrograde you may feel a lack of energy or an inability to move forward in the area of life Mars rules in your birth chart. This is not the time to start any new business ventures as they will be stalled or involve complications that will not clear until Mars turns direct. Legal battles will only frustrate you so try to hold off initiating any during this time. Mars is our physical energy and sexuality, how we pursue our goals. When retrograde you may feel as if you are hitting a wall and have to try ever so much harder to attain your goals. At this writing, **November 25th**, Mars is currently sitting on 09 degrees Taurus 52' minutes.

**December 15, 2005: Full Moon 23 Gemini 48'** - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the mutable air, sign of Gemini, this is culmination of your thoughts and a need to communicate those thoughts.

**December 16, 2005 - Venus in Sagittarius enters Aquarius.** Venus in Aquarius values freedom, individuality and detachment. Venus in Aquarius wants their partner to be their best friend too. **December 24<sup>th</sup> Venus turns retrograde!** Wait..try to not purchase anything valuable especially jewelry. Whatever you purchase during this retrograde will prove disappointing to you once Venus turns direct on **February 3, 2006** at 16 degrees of Capricorn. Old loves may reenter your life or a current love relationship may come up for review and end.

**December 22, 2005 - The Sun enters contracting Capricorn - Happy Birthday Capricorn!** Capricorn is a cardinal, earth (grounded) sign and will be discussed in next month's issue of Lunar Notes.

**December 28, 2005 - Mars at 10 degrees of Taurus squares Saturn at 10 degrees of Leo** exactly today but watch up to one week earlier as this aspect begins to culminate. This is called an approaching square and I associate it with a tidal wave. The build up of energy give us the clue and warns us to run, to take cover before the actual wave hits. Mars is anger, assertion of energy, it's hot and red and fiery. Mars is also in the sign of the Bull! Ever try to get a bull to back down?? Saturn is boundaries, restrictions, karma, buildings and structures. Saturn is in the sign of Leo and Leo is proud and dramatic. Mars wants his own way and charges ahead furiously...Saturn in the proverbial "brick wall" that says first, you need to pay \$100 to "Get out of jail" or to "pass go". Mars is head strong and says, "yeah, right" and charges ahead regardless of the penalties involved. This aspect was also exact on November 18<sup>th</sup>. However the aspect has been within 3 degrees of exactitude from November 9<sup>th</sup> through January 6<sup>th</sup>! Move slowly.

**Jupiter in Scorpio** - Jupiter begins the month of December at 07 Scorpio 36' and ends the month at 13 Scorpio 08'. See where Jupiter transits in your natal or progressed chart for further clarification. With Jupiter in Scorpio, we seek a deeper meaning of what's underneath the surface fluff. Cultivating and expanding your view of the inner dynamics of relating and gaining success in the same is likely. Jupiter is all about expansion and in Scorpio expanding your ability to penetrate deep rooted issues that have been holding you back. The ability to cultivate your perceptions and intuition is highlighted in this sign. Jupiter stays in the sign of Scorpio through November 24, 2006

**Saturn turned retrograde at 11 Leo 18 on November 22<sup>nd</sup>.** - Saturn begins the month of December at 11 Leo 14' and will end the month at 09 Leo 59'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Our outer skin is one of these boundaries that keep us "together". Saturn rules the skin, knees and skeletal structures. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure and karma. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. Saturn in Leo will restructure what we know about patriarchy, parenting, responsibility, excessive pride and the ego. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree

(Aquarius) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the effects of Saturn moving backwards in your chart.

**Uranus starts the month of December at 06 Pisces 56'**

When Uranus transits opposite natal Venus, you may encounter a new love or the break up of an existing relationship. If you have a daughter, she may prove more rebellious or in need of freedom. If Uranus is transiting opposite natal Mercury, you may feel more restless and not require as much sleep. You may have sudden flashes of insight. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life when Uranus makes contact with your personal planets.

**Neptune starts the month of December 15 Aquarius 09'**. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed when Neptune transits your personal planets Illusions shattered and pierced and the veil of denial lifted. Neptune will end the month at 15 Aquarius 56'.

**Pluto starts the month of November at 23 Sagittarius 44' and ends up at 24 Sagittarius 51'**. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing. Change doesn't always feel good. We tend to seek comfort in all things. Pluto isn't necessarily about comfort. Pluto transits feel anything but comfortable. Pluto tends to change you on a very deep psychological level. I compare Pluto's energy to erosion. It takes a very long time for the wind, sun and ocean tides to wear down the beaches and rock. Little by little with each crashing wave, particles of minerals and sand are removed. Over long periods of time, new surfaces and formations emerge sometimes changing the geography of the shoreline. This happens too within our psyche with some assistance from Pluto. Pluto and the 8<sup>th</sup> house is where psychotherapy finds its strength. Pluto is also about power. Owning your own power in the house Pluto transits is intensely focused at this time.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

NEW MOON - DECEMBER 1, 2005 - 09 Sagittarius 31"

New Moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon. In the sign of Sagittarius, it is a good time to focus on your higher education, legal issues, counseling or writing projects. This New Moon emphasizes your spiritual quest. Fixed Star Antares is conjunct this lunation. Antares is a Royal Star at the heart of the Scorpion that offers great success, worldly or otherwise. According to Bernadette Brady "The natural desire of this star is to generate success by going through a cleansing life and death experience can cause a person to seek this intensity when it is not required." It is a good star for military careers since it gives courage and a keen mentality but can also warn of self destruction.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 10 Sagittarius:

A THEATRICAL REPRESENTATION OF A GOLDEN "GODDESS OF OPPORTUNITY"

A theatrical presentation is performed at a specific time and place. Tickets are usually required in advance of the show. Without advance purchase you may not have an opportunity to see the show. This could be a once in a lifetime opportunity. This symbol seems to speak of the need to present yourself or your idea in the best possible light. If an opportunity presents itself, it could be too good to pass up...go for it!

FULL MOON - DECEMBER 15, 2005 - 23 Gemini 48'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the December 15th Full Moon falls in the sign of Gemini, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Gemini is a mutable, air sign and resides in the 3rd house of the natural zodiac, ruled by dual Mercury. In the sign of Gemini, siblings, the neighborhood, short distance travel including your automobile, learning and your thoughts and ideas will be highlighted.

Children don't often think of any consequences or danger in their play. The children are probably unaware or unconcerned with the possibility of the ice breaking only considering the fun they are experiencing. ### **The Sagittarius/Gemini Ascendant/Descendant Relationship Axis (1<sup>st</sup> house/7<sup>th</sup> house)**

As mentioned in past issues, knowing your partners 7<sup>th</sup> house cusp (the relationship house) and the ruler of that house will indicate the type of partner you may attract or are attracted to and the method of relating within a relationship.

The Ascendant or Rising sign is the sign rising on the horizon at the time of birth. This is the face we show the world, our "mask" for which our Sun hides behind. This is our outer personality, temperament and disposition as well as how we experienced our early home environment growing up. It is the way others see us and also gives indication of our physical appearance. The ruler of the Ascendant and the aspects (connections to other planets in your birth chart) further delineate and define your physical appearance.

The Descendant, or 7<sup>th</sup> house cusp, its ruler and the aspects it makes in your birth chart, is symbolic of the type of partner you are attracted to. The 7<sup>th</sup> house is the house of all partnerships including marriage and legal contracts yet also considered the house of open enemies or the Defendant in a law suit.

In relationships, Sagittarius has a planetary rulership with expansive Jupiter. If you have a Sagittarius Ascendant, you are jovial, friendly, philosophical and an independent thinker.

With Mercury ruled Gemini on the descendant you seek an affable, fun-loving, youthful and witty partner. Attraction to a partner with those qualities who is younger, intelligent, sociable, fickle, a natural born communicator is likely. It is quite possible to attract a second partner or marriage later in life with this placement. In both a male and female chart, the tendency to attract a teacher or mentor type is possible as well as meeting another who appears androgynous in some way.

One of the first things you could look at when you have the birth data of a potential partner, is their Mercury placement since Mercury rules your descendant.

It is also possible for a Sagittarius Ascendant to attract a partner who has Mercury prominent in their chart. Prominent Mercury would be in aspect to the Sun, Moon, Mars or Venus or elevated in conjunction to the MC or conjunct or ruling their Ascendant (Gemini/Virgo) or Descendant or Sun sign in Gemini or Virgo.

Knowing the date, time and place of birth is important in making the determination of the Ascendant or Rising sign, the sign rising on the horizon at the time of birth. This cusp sets up all the other house cusps that are the divisions of the houses or areas of life.
