The sign of Virgo rules how we process and analyze and digest information (the intestines), mental faculties, and the 6<sup>th</sup> house of the natural zodiac. Tarot Card # 9 - The Hermit - Symbolic of Virgo.

This card represents a person who is a teacher of the true meaning of life and who is also on a spiritual path. The Hermit stands alone and is isolated. He is cloaked in a gray (wisdom) robe, head down, eyes closed, looking within. He holds an illuminated lamp in his right hand held out and up to the sky as if guiding him on a path. The light inside of the lamp is in the shape of a star. In his left hand, a golden staff is held representing intelligence. The Hermit lights the way for others who have lost their way. When this card appears in a reading, perhaps we need to shed light on a situation in order to heal. Since light casts shadows, it also encourages us to deal with contradictions within including those of our shadow self. Virgo will assimilate spiritual knowledge and the desire to serve.

Critical thinking is blended with intuition. Good advice and pure intentions are indicated when this card appears. Introspection, attainment and realizing your purpose is possible.

Negatively, the appearance of The Hermit may imply you are being overly critical or obsessed with details and a need to organize your thoughts.

**THE HARVEST MOON (Brown Bear)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from August 23- September 22nd are born during the Harvest Moon! Their plant totem is the Violet and their animal totem is the Brown Bear! Their mineral/gemstone is the Amethyst, which is lilac, and their color is regal purple, also the color of the delicate Violet. The amethyst is said to have healing qualities and the ability to protect its wearer.

Those born during this time also belong to the Turtle Elemental Clan. Brown bear people are discriminating and analytical and they usually show good judgment. Bears have the power of Introspection. Bear also symbolizes the receptive energy of the feminine, and utilizes right brain thinking...or intuition.

VESTA - Sacred Virgin as symbol for Virgo

The Sacred Virgin depicts our lovely Asteroid Goddess Vesta, also known as Hestia by the Greeks, symbol for the sign of Virgo. Vesta was worshipped, as she was the Goddess of the hearth and keeper of the sacred flame. She had a shrine placed at the center of every home, similar to our modern day fireplaces where loved ones gather around; friends and family have the opportunity to bond. She is the brightest of the asteroids and is the only one who can be seen with the naked eye. How fitting for one who is the guardian of the sacred fires. Since Vesta was chosen to guard and protect these sacred flames, she came to symbolize food and shelter, hospitality as well as social contacts. She provided a sanctuary of protection. The Romans utilized her eternal fire and chose the Virgins at the age of 6. They took vows of chastity and celibacy lasting for the duration of their 30 years of service. Virgo = service.

My favorite myth comes from pre-Hellenistic Greece. The sacred flame the priestesses guarded symbolized the Kundalini fires of Indian Yoga practice and the secret powers of sexual alchemy. The woman who tended to these fires were known as Virgins but not because they were sexually chaste but because they remained unmarried and belong to no man. They had no need of being defined or controlled by any man. (don't you love it?? ☺) "Ms. Vesta" was way before her time...perhaps the first woman's rights activist! Now...these "virgins" actually served as sacred harlots who sexually gave of themselves to strangers! They didn't use their sexuality to attract a man or husband to satisfy their own needs but to serve a higher purpose through the process of fertilization. They provided a "service" by servicing a males sexual needs or the need to bear a child out of wedlock. Since the Vestal Virgins bore Queen-like status, the seeds planted were considered to be a sacred union and male children born from this union were considered to be "Kings". In the book "Asteroid Goddesses" by Demetra George, she suggests how "Latin kings were born of a virgin mother with no known father or to be the son of the God. In fact, many of the Kings of early Rome were the sons of Vestal Virgins".

The location of Vesta in your chart will signify withdrawals; when you have depleted your resources. Focus and illumination are keys. If you have a strong Vesta in your birth chart you may engage in sexual encounters with a variety of partners...most often to avoid long-term commitment. "Strong Vesta points to a variety of possible sexual expressions that include denial, sexual union outside of marriage, promiscuity and prostitution." Does Vesta sound vaguely similar to our modern day prostitutes or our new age Sex Therapists? The archetype is the same. Sacred sex or prostitution? You decide. Whom do you or will you serve?

What can Vesta teach us about our own sexual nature? What lessons can we learn from her? How can we utilize the symbol and mythology of Vesta to transcend our social and cultural taboos around sex, patriarchy and monogamy? Where is Vesta in your birth chart?

September, 2006

Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 ½ days.

September 4, 2006 Pluto turns direct at 24 Sagittarius 04' conjunct the Galactic Center.

September 7, 2006 - 15 Pisces 00 FULL MOON LUNAR ECLIPSE. Expect the unexpected with the energy of this full moon~! A Full Moon is a culmination of energy. With an eclipse, that energy is intensified.

September 7, 2006 - Venus in Leo enters Virgo at the time of the Full Moon Lunar Eclipse. Venus in Virgo is sensual and sensitive to criticism. Venus in the earthy sign of Virgo values order analysis. Venus in Virgo is attracted to perfection, health and cleanliness.

September 9, 2006 - Mars enters Libra. Mars in the sign of Libra desires emotional relationships with others. Mars in this sign is sensuous and impulsive in love yet prefers to be sought after rather than assertive or the aggressor. Artistic expression is prominent.

September 13, 2006 - Mercury in Virgo enters Libra. Mercury in Libra is fair and complementary. In this sign you will desire to know both sides of a situation before making any decision.

September 22, 2006 - 29 Virgo 20" NEW MOON LUNAR ECLIPSE - New Beginnings in Mercury ruled Virgo; health, pets, details, professionalism, perfectionism and logical solutions symbolize this New moon. With an eclipse, expect to feel its energy a week in advance, then in December (the square), March '07 (the opposition), June '07 (the square), September '07 (the conjunction)

September 23, 2006 - Sun enters Venus ruled Libra. Happy Birthday Libra! More will be discussed about Libra in our next issue.

Jupiter in Scorpio begins the month at 13 Scorpio 24' and ends the month at 18 Scorpio 18'.

Saturn, lord of karma begins the month at 17 Leo 57' and ends the month at 21 Leo 15'.

Uranus continues to retrograde until November 19, 2006 when it turns direct at 10 Pisces 48'. Electric **Uranus** begins the month at 12 Pisces 55' and ends the month at 11 Pisces 48 rx.

Neptune continues to retrograde on until October 29th, 2006. Currently at 17 Aquarius 51" and ends the month at 17 Aquarius 15'

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others

have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

FULL MOON PARTIAL LUNAR ECLIPSE - September 7, 2006- 15 Pisces 00'.

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the August 9th Full Moon falls in the sign of Aquarius, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Aquarius is a fixed, air and resides in the 11th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by electric Uranus. In the sign of Aquarius, this Full Moon will intensify your feelings of independence and freedom and restrictions of any kind will be summarily dismissed. New ideas or flashes of insight are possible. A Full Moon increases in light and is always a culmination of energy.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 16 Pisces:

IN A QUIET MOMENT, A CREATIVE INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCES THE FLOW OF INSPIRATION.

In order for creative mind to create there need be a time and place away from everything. It is within the silence, that a spark ignites a thought or idea. Inspiration only flows during the quiet time we permit ourselves. Meditation is one way that we are spiritually inspired. This symbol positively expresses the need to spend time alone and that contemplation will provide you with the right attitude in which to solve a problem. Uncluttering the mind permits clarity to surface. Channeling thoughts and feelings is possible.



NEW MOON SOLAR ECLIPSE - September 22, 2006 - 29 Virgo 20" The New Moon is about new beginnings. Seeds and ideas that are planted during the New Moon have the opportunity to grow, blossom and flourish during the Full Moon.

SYMBOL FOR 30 Virgo

HAVING AN URGENT TASK TO COMPLETE, A MAN DOESN'T LOOK TO ANY DISTRACTIONS

This symbol's meaning is synchronistic to the Lunar Eclipse symbol. With the Lunar Eclipse we look within and quiet our mind for answers. Lunar Eclipses are always internal changes while Solar Eclipses are changes that come from the environment and through others.

With this symbol we often need to over focus and maintain tunnel vision in order to achieve our goals. Unwavering loyalty is needed in order to achieve our dreams. Maintaining focused direction is important now.

The symbol reminds me of the expression about "having a mission". There is a need to maintain complete attention to the situation at hand. Avoiding temptations and distractions is critical to achieving the desired result. Now is not the time to procrastinate. Do not allow outside influences to misdirect your attention. In order to achieve your objective, you must stay true to yourself.

Staying on your spiritual path no matter what is indicated.

SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:

The Virgo/Pisces Ascendant/Descendant Relationship Axis (1st house/7th house)

As mentioned in past issues, knowing your partners 7th house cusp (the relationship house) and the ruler of that house will indicate the type of partner you may attract or are attracted to and the method of relating within a relationship.

The Ascendant or Rising sign is the sign rising on the horizon at the time of birth. This is the face we show the world, our "mask" for which our Sun hides behind. This is our outer personality, temperament and disposition as well as our early environment growing up. It is the way others see us and also gives indication of our physical appearance. The ruler of the Ascendant and the aspects (connections to other planets in your birth chart) further delineate and define your appearance.

The Descendant, or 7th house cusp, its ruler and the aspects it makes in your birth chart, is symbolic of the type of partner you are attracted to. The 7th house is the house of partnerships of all types including marriage and legal contracts yet also considered the house of open enemies or the Defendant in a law suit.

For example, Leo Rising people are self aware, warm and stylish. Their personal appearance is important to them and they seek lots of attention. Their natural enthusiasm, energy and optimism is magnetic. You can recognize a Leo Ascendant by their hair, straight posture and their great big smile. They make good Managers and are natural promoters....even if they are prone to temper tantrums~!

In relationships Virgo rising has cerebral, reserved self image. There is the aura of proper etiquette and Virgo's are usually reserved. In love, this placement would require one to be of service to another. Very often Virgo risings tend to not attract partners who are good for them. Often love relationships are a struggle when one is required to care for another. Sexually Virgo may be prone to seek perfection. Cleanliness is important. Sometimes in seeking perfection this placement will experiment with bisexuality, homosexuality or even remain sexually chaste.

With Pisces on the Descendant, attraction to a partner who is illusive in some way. He or she can be an alcoholic, a drug user, chronic liar, or one who lives in a dream world. Virgo can have martyr-like tendencies and project the need to "save" his partner from himself. Whatever we do not own and acknowledge in ourselves (Ascendant) we will attract externally (Descendant) to mirror our desires and teach us necessary lessons in relating.

Knowing the date, time and place of birth is important in making the determination of the Ascendant or Rising sign, the sign rising on the horizon at the time of birth, which set up all the other house cusps that are the divisions of the houses or areas of life.
