**Happy Birthday Sagittarius the Archer!** Happy Birthday to all of those born from November 22 - December 21! Key Phrase for Sagittarius is "**I SEEK** "

Sagittarians are the Idealists and dreamers of the zodiac. Sagittarius is a mutable (changeable, flexible), fire (intuitive, impulsive, idealistic) sign located in the Western Hemisphere of the chart. Your ruling planet is expansive and "benefic" Jupiter. Jupiter and the sign of Sagittarius reside in the 9<sup>th</sup> house of the zodiac. The 9<sup>th</sup> house is typically linked to long distance travel, philosophies and belief systems, religions, higher education and teaching, publishing, counseling and legal issues as well as exploring new horizons. Sagittarius sure does love to teach...or preach for that matter! Horses are usually linked to the sign of Sagittarius and the 9<sup>th</sup> house although most large animals coincide to the 12<sup>th</sup> house. I'll discuss why horses are in the 9<sup>th</sup> when Chiron is mentioned later in the newsletter. There is always that urge to align themselves with a greater ideal or truth and understanding of all subjects. Sagittarians may appear to act larger than life...well if your ruling planet was Jupiter you might feel the same! Jupiter does become excessive at times and that often translates to being overly idealistic, self-righteous and opinionated. Sagittarians tend to have a dream and a goal..and once they get there, they may change their mind about it because they do not want anyone to burst that idealistic bubble. Sagittarians have a unique way of rationalizing everything too. They are known to have foot-in-mouth-disease. Meaning: Open Wide and stick foot in as far as it can go! If you want the truth and nothing but the truth so help you G -d, ask a Sagittarian. They will blurt it out willingly, with an impish smile...and then an apology...if you're that fortunate. This quality is to be admired about Sagittarians because they can be brutally honest and you will always know exactly where you stand when in their company.

Jupiter, Sag's ruling planet, has a cycle of approximately 12 years. The planet Jupiter is our largest planet and is known to have quite a few moons! In fact, we aren't even sure how many moons (women) Jupiter has because new ones are surfacing and being discovered all the time! That Jupiter was discovered to have so many more moons shouldn't surprise us because it is the planet of "abundance". He was also known to be a womanizer in mythology. In the October issue of Lunar Notes, we discussed Juno, Jupiter's wife. She was acutely aware of how many moons, I mean women, were in Jupiter's life. Whatever Jupiter touches by transit in your birth chart will literally expand in nature. Jupiter can bring wonderful gifts and some have even called him "Santa Claus". However, you know the expression about too much of a good thing, right? Sometimes when Jupiter transits areas of your chart, there can be financial gain or weight gain! Excessive behavior, exaggeration or over doing it can be linked to Jupiter.

According to Ariel Guttman and Kenneth Johnson's *Mythic Astrology*, correlations between Chiron, Jupiter and Sagittarius are apparent. It was known that Jupiter spent most of his time pursuing his many love interests. The question of faithfulness always surfaces when discussing the sign of Sagittarius because Sagittarians are always searching or wanting the next adventure, particularly if it is outdoors. They are usually committed to their current partner and that isn't usually the issue. "But how LONG they can sustain themselves in that commitment is another question. "Til Death do us part" is not a credo that Sagittarians hold dear (unless the chart contains strong Juno or Cancer symbolism)..and when pushed against the wall to say those words they usually tremble". My own experience with this is in the December 2002 Issue ☺

Sagittarius' polar opposite (9th house - higher educations, beliefs, philosophies, legal matters, publishing and teaching) is the mutable, air sign Gemini (3rd house - thoughts, communication, siblings, early education including teachers, short distance travel and automobiles). The integration and forming of philosophies and beliefs are some areas of life for Sagittarius, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite, the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Sagittarius can become ...just like mutable, airy Gemini, ruled by Mercury and become scattered and fickle and non-committal.

When Jupiter transits your birth chart or if Jupiter is significantly placed in your chart, you may experience benefit, fortune or excess. For instance, my Jupiter is located in my 11<sup>th</sup> house of friends, associations, counseling and hopes and wishes. This is an area of my life where I feel most "fortunate" since I've always had the most wonderful friends and have been fortunate in the ability to counsel others with Astrology.

### **CHIRON - The Wounded Healer, Teacher, Seeker and Maverick**

"He's everything you want, he's everything you need, he's everything inside of you that you wish you could be, he says all the right things, at exactly the right time, but he means nothing to you and you don't know why" - Vertical Horizon

In Mythology, when Chiron was born, his mother rejected him because he was born a Centaur...half man and half horse. When his parents Hera & Zeus saw their new son's image they abandoned him, repulsed by his body and physical form. Chiron's first wound was psychological - one of abandonment and rejection and a perpetual longing for the love and "relationship" to his parents, especially that of his mother. The astrological glyph or symbol for the sign of Sagittarius is just that, a Centaur holding a bow and arrow pointed to the heavens....and into the distance.

Chiron's physical wound was in his foot and thigh, injured by a poison arrow, affecting his mobility. Sagittarians (horses) need lots of freedom to roam around. When that freedom is restricted or there is a "perceived" restriction then Chiron/Sagittarius really feels wounded. There can't be anything worse than being trapped in a physical body that doesn't feel right to us. Chiron spent much time in his cave studying the stars, medicine, spirituality, mathematics and music. He was able to utilize these disciplines to heal others and in turn heal himself; hence, The Wounded Healer archetype.

One of Chiron's life lessons is relinquishing his painful memories from childhood. Because Chiron is immortal, his pain and suffering is eternal. Much of his pain was of his own making. When we are able to heal our primary wound (s) in life, we are usually able to utilize that experience to assist others with similar wounds and painful life experiences and in turn, heal our self. That is if we choose this path. Oftentimes, people can be in so much emotional pain and turmoil, or have not forgiven their parents, others or themselves so they choose to harm others as a projection of their own needs not having been met. A vicious cycle ensues and you will attract others to play out your dramas for you to take a look at, time and time again.

As Chiron matured, he became quite a wise teacher (Sagittarius/Jupiter) and a Shaman/Healer. The placement of Chiron in your birth chart shows your deepest wound by house position and aspects it makes to other planets and cusps (the divisions of the signs) in your birth chart. This is also the place you will find your greatest strengths and ability to heal others and are able to exert or project this knowledge out into the environment. Chiron connections are very significant in synastry. Synastry is the comparison of two birth charts that shows compatibility and relationship to each other. When people enter into relationships where there is a strong Chiron connection, the relationship takes on a fated quality. These relationships are usually not easy at first. The difficulties inherent in Chironic relationships must be overcome for the personal growth of both individuals. That

**Tarot Card # 20 XIV - Temperance - Symbolic of Sagittarius**

In the Rider-Waite version, you see the Angel Temperance - Archangel Michael. He has the solar symbol on his head with light rays streaming outward from it. In each hand a cup is held, one cup is silver (feminine) and one gold (masculine). Water pours and vibrates (waves) and is blended from one cup to the other. This blending of fire and water, masculine and feminine and the conscious and unconscious also symbolizes conception. The number 14 is the most fertile day of a woman's cycle.

The Symbol of Temperance may appear in a reading during a time when emotional balance is required. There may be emotional days ahead or a need to balance and/or adapt our emotions to bring about positive and "creative" results. If this card turns up next to the Empress or the Sun, a conception or baby may be on the way!

**LONG SNOWS MOON (Elk)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from November 22nd- December 21st are born under the Long Snows Moon and their animal totem is the Elk. Their color is black and obsidian is their totem in the mineral kingdom. Obsidian is a type of volcanic glass that is usually shiny like glass. It has razor-sharp edges and therefore should always be "handled carefully." Obsidian was used in carvings and for jewelry as well as for mirrors. It was also crafted for use in arrowheads. Because obsidian comes from deep within the earth it is said to be a grounding mineral.

Elk people are very similar to the properties of obsidian. They can be good mirrors for other people as well as project "their stuff" onto others. They are often rough around the edges or difficult to get to know because of the uneven outer surface. Elk people can be very protective of those they love or from "perceived" danger. "They try to get as many cows as they can into their harem, and they will fervently defend them from the approaches of any other male". (Medicine Wheel-Earth Astrology, Sun Bear and Wabun) They are often introspective and clairvoyant. The Elk is a very strong and elegant animal and perhaps one of the most regal in the deer family. Men of this totem are competitive with each other about the women in their lives and can be prone to fits of rage or jealousy that may come as a surprise to those close to them.

**December 8: Full Moon in Gemini** - A full moon is a culmination of energy and in the sign of Gemini it is cerebral. Racing thoughts and ideas may overwhelm you during this full moon. Children and siblings may be the emphasized focus. Please watch crazy drivers on the road and try to not drive too quickly!

**December 17, 2003: Mercury goes retrograde in the sign of Capricorn** – Then on the last day of the month, Mercury will shift back into the sign of Sagittarius for 15 days. Thoughts turn inward for clarification of what is practical for building a future. Mercury in cardinal, earth is methodical and practical and plans for the future. In this retreat it is important to reflect and review past decisions. When Mercury retrogrades it is not the best time to make important decisions or purchases. Whenever an important decision is made during this retrograde cycle, there is usually some piece of information that is either missing or that we have forgotten. Wait for Mercury to turn direct on January 5<sup>th</sup> before signing any important documents or make any mechanical purchases. Back up your computer systems because all “communication” devices freak out during this time! Missed phone calls, voice messages not playing properly can be expected when Mercury turns backwards.

**December 17, 2003: Mars enters the fiery sign of Aries** – Mars is comfortable in his own sign. Mars in Aries is enthusiastic, assertive, attention seeking and ready to go!

**December 22, 2003: Venus in Capricorn enters Aquarius** – Venus in Capricorn wanted a return for its money and in Aquarius is more desiring of freedom and independence. Our erratic and unpredictable planet Uranus rules the sign of Aquarius so expect some sudden surprises in while Venus transits this sign!

**December 23, 2003 – Sun enters Capricorn - Winter Solstice** - Happy Birthday Capricorn! Capricorn is cardinal (initiates action) earth (practical and grounded). We will look forward to discussing the sign of Capricorn in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

**December 23, 2003 – New Moon - 01 Capricorn 08'** New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. In Capricorn we want to work really hard at what brings us public recognition or being recognized for the good job we do in our career of choice. It might be a good time to move into or purchase a new residence/Real Estate.

**December 25, 2003 - Merry Christmas** to all who celebrate this holiday!

**Juno will stay in the sign of the Archer** all month beginning at 11 Sagittarius and ending the month at 22 Sagittarius. Juno In Sagittarius wants a sporty friend, someone to pal around with. Friendship, having fun and freedom of movement and independence is important to those who have Juno in Sagittarius.

**Jupiter stays in earthy Virgo.** Jupiter starts the month at 17 Virgo 07' and ends up at 18 Virgo 52'. With Jupiter in Virgo, we may take a step back and be more discerning in our expansiveness. Our pleasures may be more reserved, tempered or serious. Jupiter in Virgo will be much more practical and realistic than when in the sign of Leo. All of the Virgos out there should be receiving some nice benefits with Jupiter in Virgo transiting your Sun.

**Saturn is still retrograde through March 7, 2004** – Saturn turned Retrograde at 13 Cancer 14' and its current degree is 12 Cancer 05'. Saturn in Cancer is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our

commitments to our personal structure. In relationships, while Saturn is retrograde (backward motion) Saturn wants us to rethink and finish up any obligations or promises we have made that do not suit our purpose. If commitments made are no longer working then its time to set limits set boundaries about what we expect. If a relationship is not working, this is the time to let it go. Saturn ends up the month at 09 degrees Cancer 50.

**Uranus in Aquarius** - Uranus starts the month at 29 Aquarius 06' and will enter 00 Pisces on the last day of the month, December 31, 2003. When Uranus went direct last month, any planet in his path was affected by sudden shifts and change. Initially oppositions of 0-4 degrees of Virgo were affected then 2-4 degrees of Gemini and Sagittarius (the squares). As Uranus moves out of the sign of Aquarius, his opposite Leo will be greatly impacted as well as the squares of planets in 28, 29, 30 degrees Taurus and Scorpio. Uranus has been rather disruptive in Aquarius and has been trouble causing for some with planets in Leo. Rest assured that Uranus, when entering the sign of Pisces at months end, will not transit the sign of Aquarius again in your lifetime ☺

**Neptune starts the month at 10 Aquarius 49' and ends up at 11 Aquarius 39'.** If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

**Pluto starts the month at 19 Sagittarius 19' and ends the month at 20 Sagittarius 27'.** Whatever Pluto touches in your chart will leave an imprint in your psyche. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul!

#### **SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

#### **FULL MOON December 8, 2003 - 16 Gemini 20**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and

especially in her own sign. Since the December 8th Full Moon falls in the sign of Gemini, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Gemini is a mutable, air sign and resides in the 3rd house of the zodiac, ruled by the planet of communication, Mercury. Issues involving siblings, your neighborhood and neighbors, thoughts, and travel may be the focus. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

**SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 17 Gemini:**

**THE HEAD OF A ROBUST YOUTH CHANGES INTO THAT OF A MATURE THINKER**

This seems to be a time when one needs to "grow up". The thought processes may speed up and the intuitive function may heighten. Wisdom is usually acquired as we mature. This symbol implies that we have changed and are no longer the same. Our thoughts and desires may have changed as a result of our personal growth or events in our lives that have forced us to grow and change our thinking. Making wise decisions so that we do not have to look back or backtrack is also symbolized.

This may also mean losing our innocence, making decisions based upon our past experiences and/or life changing events...and never looking back.

**NEW MOON December 23, 2003 - 1 Capricorn 08**

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Capricorn rules the 10th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be your public reputation, real estate, your mother (I use the 10<sup>th</sup> house for the mother), career and business affairs as well as the government.

**SABIAN SYMBOL for 2 Capricorn:**

**THREE STAINED-GLASS WINDOWS IN A GOTHIC CHURCH, ONE DAMAGED BY WAR**

One of the windows of the Church has been damaged by war. We usually feel a sense of safety and feeling of protection in a Church. Here we see that war can break through even this area of our lives. This symbol may also show how our religious and philosophical opinions and differences can "shatter" our faith and create a loss of hope. It may take a while to repair the "stained" glass window. Bloodshed comes to mind. It takes time and effort to repair a stained glass window for there are usually many pieces of differing shapes and colors that need to be re-positioned so that the window appears "fixed". Windows are also

"Neptunian" - a looking glass. Perhaps it is our "illusions" of philosophical and religious freedom that are being shattered in this image.

A client recently came to me for advice on his current relationship. The girl he has been dating for the last few years one day picked up and left and moved to another state. He felt hurt and confused and needed some guidance. When we talked I wanted to know more about this girl so he proceeded to tell me about her and even showed me her photo. I was appreciative of his candid openness. He proceeded to explain to me all of his needs that were "not" met in this relationship. I'm not sure if he really heard what he was telling me to I repeated and mirrored back what he revealed. It was as if he didn't want to believe or see what was really going on in that relationship. Perhaps this girl was a pleasant sexual distraction to meet those sexual needs on demand. When we spoke, he became a bit angry and feeling used by this girl. The only needs that were really being met in this relationship were his needs to feel desired by a much younger, attractive girl and to have his sexual needs met. This girl's behavior in this relationship leaves much to be desired and I won't reveal the details of that here. Suffice to say that even though he was distraught in her sudden departure, there was concern for her return, if that were the case. After listening to his words I realized that he was involved in an addictive relationship.

Signs you are in an Addictive Relationship:

1. **Lack of Trust:** People don't trust each other in an addictive relationship. They will frequently accuse the other person of some behavior that just doesn't exist.
2. **Isolation:** Addictive Relationships are isolating. They spend all their time alone without the company of friends, more than likely in the bedroom. In healthy relationships they socially integrate, keep their friends and are involved with family.
3. **Values:** Addictive Relationships inherently violate a persons fundamental nature. Ex: acting against what you value most or changing who you are to be with this person.
4. **Cycles of Repeating Pain:** There is intense pleasure/OBSESSION, intense pain, blame your partner for it all, then blame yourself for it then the cycle starts with the obsession, intense pain etc., etc.

In the "real" world and in healthy relationships we want a partner who is reliable and somewhat predictable, one we can introduce to our friends and family and feel proud of, one that we can call a "partner" because we work together, not against each other. We care for each other and want the best for our partner. This client wasn't receiving any of those things or having his emotional needs met on any level. Yet, when this was brought to his attention, he felt that they needed to be together because of the sexual aspect of the relationship so wonderful. Very often ones sexuality is used to seduce and/or manipulate a partner who has missed this aspect in their life with their last partner. This man was out of a long-term relationship and subsequent marriage. For anyone who has been in one lasting longer than 10 years, well that area of life slows down a bit...especially once children arrive on the scene...life kicks in. That this young girl desired him and met his sexual needs, on demand, was perhaps all he initially desired..then as with anything else we become hooked/addicted even if we are not getting other more important needs met.

If we review the October Issue of Lunar Notes Relationships section, you will see the instructions for the "Wish List". What is it that I want and need in a relationship, what makes me happy and what am I willing to compromise to be in one. Without knowing this very important screening criteria, we set ourselves up to falling in love first and getting to really know the person later. By doing this, we set ourselves up for love addiction or sexual addiction if you will. It's great falling in love...so long as you know who you're falling in love with before you hop into bed ☺ We really don't think clearly or well when we are standing naked before a lover..so why not screen the person first to see if they are actually sane and meet at least part of the criteria on our Wish List?

There are addictive styles and healthy styles of relating within relationships. Until we understand the difference, we will be forced to replay our child of origin scripts, the roles imprinted on us from our family of origin as adults.
