**Happy Birthday Pisces!** For those born **between February 19th - March 20th** The Key Phrase is: **I Believe**. Pisces is a Mutable (changeable, flexible), water (feelings and emotions) sign located in the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Pisces governs the last house, the 12<sup>th</sup> house of the natural zodiac. The 12<sup>th</sup> house involves areas of our life such as hospitals, institutions, confinement, dreams, large animals, psychic influences and meditation, solitude, secret sorrows, sensing, and the subconscious to name a few. Pisceans are usually the people who are willing to most sacrifice themselves for others. They are compassionate and idealistic, often to a fault. Pisces sun, or if you have Pisces strong in your birth chart, are often very intuitive and have psychic ability. Several of my friends are Pisces or have Neptune prominent in their birth chart.

Pisces in health issues relates to the feet and immune system ... strange illnesses that creep up on you or that were hidden such as anemia, HIV, AIDS, or Herpes may develop. Pisces' polar opposite (12<sup>th</sup> house - hospitals) is Virgo (6<sup>th</sup> house- health) The immune system is under strain when Neptune transits make difficult angle connections in our birth chart. (conjunctions, squares, oppositions and quincunx)

Your ruling planet is the dreamy, wispy, illusive and mutable planet Neptune. Neptune is fog...you simply can't "grasp" it and it's often too dense to see through it. If Neptune is strong in your chart, you may have artistic or musical ability. Since Neptune/Pisces rules the feet, ballet dancers and dancers of all kinds may fall under Neptune's domain. Neptune can "blur" our vision of reality and cause self-deception or draw deceptive people and situations to us. Neptune and/or Neptune transits are prevalent in addictions of all kinds. With Venus/Neptune there could be deception in love, idealistic expectations of the loved one, affairs or alcoholism and drug abuse. The positive manifestation could be artistic ability and compassion. Mars/Neptune can dissipate energy, energy "leaks" are common, and passive/aggressive behavior is likely. The positive manifestation might be psychic ability. Neptune and Pisces often have loose boundaries. Boundaries are limitations, what we will

and will not tolerate from others. Often, when Neptune, Pisces and the 12<sup>th</sup> house are involved, we may have boundary issues especially in our interpersonal relationships. This may have been learned by invasive or overbearing parents or siblings when we were children. We feel deception within the parental household on an unconscious level...parents may have kept secrets from the children or from each other. This may manifest in boundary issues as we grow and begin to engage in relationship. There is something vague, that we do not trust. Sometimes we give up too much or not enough just to be in a relationship or within our friendship or working environment. Often we don't know where to draw the line or we allow others to overstep the boundaries too often using us a doormat.

THE HANGED MAN Card - Number 12

The Hanged Man card in the Tarot deck is card #12 and is symbolic of sacrifice. In this way the Hanged Man relates to the sign of Pisces. The Hanged Man is hanging upside down, tied by one foot with the other leg folded behind him freely, with his hands behind his back and a lovely glowing halo crowning his head. Upon first glance you may think he is being punished for some reason and being held captive. Upon closer examination, he doesn't look unhappy in this position. He is a willing victim/participant and seems at peace. We often must sacrifice and give up our confining thoughts and ideas from our past in order to see the light and seek enlightenment. We must push aside temptations or instant gratification and just "hang around" and wait it out! When I see this card in a reading it can mean the need to take a pause in the question at hand. Sometimes it means a lack of commitment in a

relationship reading or being at a stand still or cross roads. Someone isn't sure about the relationship...only one foot in the relationship.

**BIG WINDS MOON (Cougar)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from February 19<sup>th</sup> - March 20<sup>th</sup> are born under the Big Winds Moon and their animal totem is the Cougar. Their color is blue-green of the turquoise and turquoise is also their totem in the mineral kingdom. They are of the Frog Elemental clan.

The stone turquoise is one of the oldest stones used for adornment and protection. Native Americans utilize this stone in much of their jewelry. When worn it was thought to keep its owner from injury or danger.

Cougar people often have healing powers and the ability to heal others. They are comfortable in magical and mystical realms. These people have the ability to absorb both positive and negative energy from others so it is important for them to always stay grounded in earth.

The Cougar is a cat and like all cats, a hunter and enjoys the chase in a hunt. This cat is one of the best runners and climbers. Their speed and endurance is exemplary. They are also swift in their mind and capable of going to distant places that few others travel. Balance is essential to their well being. When off balance they become moody but with the proper direction can be most productive.

March 6: Full Moon at 16 Virgo 43 - A full moon is a culmination of energy and in the sign of Virgo it is discriminating and cautious. Thoughts, discrimination, communications, health issues and working partners may prevail during this full moon.

March 6, 2004: Venus enters Taurus - Venus is comfortable in her own sign. Venus in Taurus is affectionate, romantic and demonstrative. People with Venus in Taurus have a keen eye for luxury, art and are usually interested in music.

March 7, 2004 - Saturn turns direct - Saturn in Cancer is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. In relationships, while Saturn was retrograde (backward motion) Saturn wants us to rethink and finish up any obligations or promises we have made that do not suit our purpose. If commitments made are no longer working then it was time to set limits set boundaries about what we expect. If a relationship was not working, this was the time to let it go. As Saturn turns direct, we can breathe a sigh of relief and the vice will be lifted if we did the work necessary during it's backward journey.

March 13, 2004: Mercury enters Aries- This is a strong position for Mercury. Mercury in Aries is impatient, outspoken and aggressive. Often impulsive, this position can be argumentative and tactless.

March 20, 2003 - Sun enters Aries - Happy Birthday Aries! Aries is cardinal (initiates action) fire (intuition, action, daring). We will look forward to discussing the sign of Aries in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

March 20, 2004 - New Moon - 00 Aries 39' New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. In Aries, the first sign of the zodiac you may want to focus on yourself, your appearance, starting a new project. 00 Aries is the Equinox and new beginnings.

March 22, 2004 - Mars enters Gemini -Mars in Gemini is lightening fast and very energetic. Conclusions are drawn in a flash but the problem is that there is no staying power. Gemini is a mutable (changeable) sign and this placement may cause more vacillation in making decisions.

March 24, 2004 - Pluto goes retrograde - starts the month 22 Sagittarius 05'. Whatever Pluto touches in your chart will leave an imprint in your psyche. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! When retrograde, this energy is turned inward.

Jupiter still retrogrades (rx). Jupiter starts the month at 14 Virgo 23' and ends up at 10 Virgo 44'. With Jupiter in Virgo, we may take a step back and be more discerning in our expansiveness. Our pleasures may be more reserved, tempered or serious. Inner spiritual growth rather than outer growth is the key. We may not feel as "lucky" with Jupiter retrograde. Jupiter in Virgo is much more practical and realistic than when in the sign of Leo. All of the Virgos out there should be receiving some nice benefits with Jupiter in Virgo transiting your Sun...try to not don't over due it!

Uranus in Pisces - Uranus the month at 03 Pisces 14' and will end the month at 04 Pisces 15'. Compassion and sympathy for the underdog is possible. Unique water systems are likely to be developed. Issues concerning our waters/oceans and sea life may be emphasized with Uranus in Pisces. Planets in Virgo are in opposition to Uranus in Pisces and there may be new health issues (Virgo) that surface in relationship to our drinking water (Pisces) or immune system.

Neptune in Aquarius - starts the month at 13 Aquarius 53' and ends up at 14 Aquarius 47'. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree)

opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

FULL MOON March 6, 2004 - 16 Virgo 43'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Since the March 6th Full Moon falls in the sign of Virgo, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Virgo is a mutable, earth sign and resides in the 6th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by messenger, Mercury. Issues involving people who work for you, pets, day- to-day affairs, your health and aunts and uncles may be your focus. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 17 Virgo:

A VOLCANIC ERUPTION BRINGING DUST CLOUDS, FLOWING LAVA, EARTH RUMBLINGS

Volcano's tend to lie dormant until the internal pressure becomes so great that an eruption is eminent. Rumbings are a warning of an impending threat. A powerful force has built up to the point that it can no longer be withheld or concealed.

This may symbolize circumstances or a situation that has been simmering "under the surface" for some time. Self-expression is necessary. The eruption can be angry. Repressed anger explodes and spews forward a torrent of thoughts and emotions. Watch out for over reactions and wait for the 'dust to settle"

NEW MOON March 20, 2004 - 00 Aries 49'

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Aries rules the 1st house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be you're your outer appearance, assertiveness or initiating a new project.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 1 Aries:

A WOMAN HAS RISEN OUT OF THE OCEAN, A SEAL EMBRACES HER

This degree is right on the cusp of Pisces and Aries and you see the image of a woman emerging from the sea with a Seal. This marks the beginning of the spring Equinox in the Northern hemisphere. New cycles and new beginnings are symbolized.

Surprises, emergence and awareness of new ideas are also symbolized.

FORGIVENESS

In my opinion, forgiveness is something that must be earned by the forgivee. Has this person admitted their wrongdoing? Have they learned from their mistakes and are they making any changes in themselves and in their lives to ensure that it never happens again? Have they done anything to repair the damage they caused? If not, then this individual has not EARNED your forgiveness, and it is NOT your fault if you have not forgiven them. They may try to make you feel guilty because they want you to forgive them without having to do "the hard stuff" themselves.

However, I know how horrible it is to be holding on to anger because someone has done the unforgivable, and it is necessary to find a way to release that poisonous anger, even if I do not forgive the wrongdoer.

Here is where unconditional love comes in. It means "I love you without condition, because you exist and I acknowledge the Divine good within you. Because I love you unconditionally, I hold no ill will toward you, and I wish only the best for you." It does NOT mean "I trust you with my life, my body and my possessions" that kind of love IS conditional and must be developed over time and tested by our daily interactions with each other. The only way this type of love is actualized, is over time, and in experiencing consistent interactions with others that feel safe.

It is possible to forgive someone without trusting them. If someone has verbally abused me, and then came to me and said, "I'm so sorry, I'm feeling insecure and when you said "this", I reacted like "that", and I'm trying to do better, I apologize for verbally attacking you because of my own feelings of insecurity", I would forgive them and embrace them and encourage them in their growing process. But I might still feel it was prudent to keep my

heart safe, until I knew they were a little stronger. So "little niggling thoughts" may not be an indication of lack of forgiveness, but rather your intelligent awareness that the person you're thinking of has not yet achieved the state of "trustworthiness" that you are looking for.
